Mitavite Xtra-Cool Interschools Derby - 14th Sept 2008



Your school's chance to be part of the Bates Sydney International Three-Day Event

Mitavite and Sydney International Eventing Inc are proud to invite Schools from New South Wales to be part of this year's Bates Sydney International Three-Day Event. By competing in the Mitavite Xtra-Cool Interschools Derby or volunteering you can be part of one of the premier Three-Day Events in Australia.

This initiative is proudly sponsored by Mitavite and is all about giving young riders within NSW the opportunity to meet Australia's top event riders, compete at the Sydney Olympics venue and have some fun along the way.

What is the Mitavite Xtra-Cool Interschools Derby?

A Derby involves each rider completing a jumping course comprising at least 50% natural obstacles. Like eventing it's not about who can go the fastest but which team can go the closest to optimum time without incurring any penalties.

The Mitavite Xtra-Cool Interschools Derby will be run as a teams event (2 riders per team). It will be held in the Main Arena on the Final Day of competition – Sunday 14 September 2008 and 5 teams will run between each of the show jumping rounds of the eventing classes. The presentation will be just before the CCI*** show jumping. All teams will need to be at the venue by 8.00 am for briefing and course walk.

The event will be conducted in accordance with the EFA NSW's rules for Interschools and the National Eventing Rules. Maximum height 95cm. The team with the least penalties and closest to optimum time will be the winner.

Each team will consist of two qualified riders. Each school may nominate up to two teams of two qualified riders per team. Alternatively riders may enter as a combined school team (i.e. 2 riders from different schools). A Maximum of 15 teams will compete. The second team nominated by a School will only compete if there are insufficient nominations from other schools.

To enter you must be a member of EFA NSW. Entry is free. **For those competitors who need to arrive the day before stabling and camping is available**, please complete the attached stabling form with your entry including payment.

The members of the winning team will each receive a one hour lesson with one of Team Mitavite Eventing Riders. The winning team will also receive rugs, ribbons and Mitavite Xtra-Cool horse feed. Ribbons will be awarded to eighth place thanks to EFA NSW.

If you are not competing why not volunteer?

By volunteering at the Three-Day Event you will receive free entry for all days so you can cheer for your school mates in the Mitavite Xtra-Cool Interschools Derby.

All ponies or horses have to be checked by the official event veterinarian before entering the stable area and will be required to wear a bridle number at all times.

Access to stables will be limited to those persons who have been issued a stable wrist band (NOT Transferable). 24 hour security will be placed on the stables from Tuesday 9 September to Sunday 14 September. Up to 4 stable wrist bands will be issued on arrival to those competitors using the stables.

Movement of horses between the stables, practice, grazing and main arena must be restricted to the areas as indicated by the Stewards.
